General Canteen Updates:

Our 2024-2025 calendar is filling up fast! If you are a leader of an event that is hosted regularly, please reach out and ensure that your event is in the book.

The Upper Deck Remodel is almost complete, huge thank you to our House Committee Chair, Greg S., for all of his assistance in making this project come to life! My hope is that by the time you're reading this, our new saloon doors will be installed with the project officially complete.

Our next focus is the front bar remodel. Kathy Hanna has been the Queen of 50:50 raffles, working hard to raise the



money we will need to complete this project. This project includes revising the size and location of the island behind the front bar, adding a floor drain on the front bar side of the pass-through window, installing an ice bin and soda gun for the pass-through window, and updating display and storage spaces behind the front bar. For those of you that remember our kitchen remodel, one of the few remaining pieces is the installation of a floor drain so we can install our commercial steamer. That steamer will provide the canteen with a multitude of new and unique menu options. My hope is that we can work with the plumbing and contractors to install the floor drains for both the front bar and the kitchen.
