Auxiliary President's Column

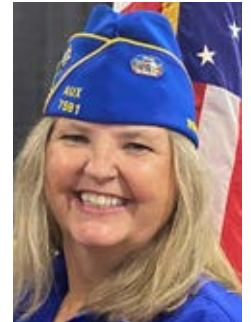
Sisters and brothers,
